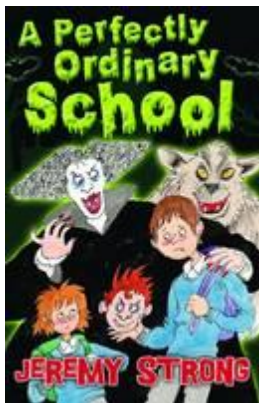

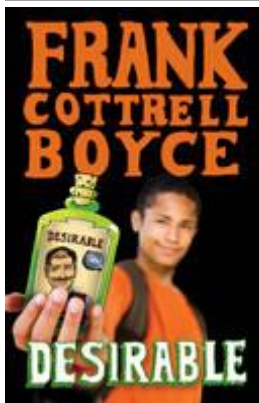


**A Perfectly Ordinary School**

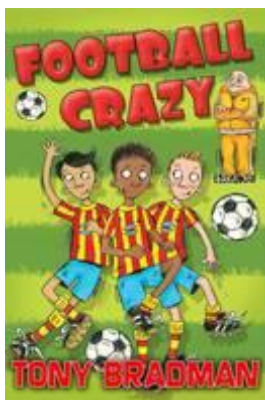


**Desirable**

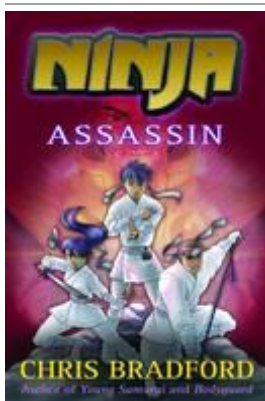


**Football Crazy**

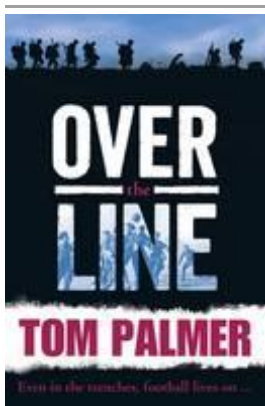


**Ninja: Assassin**

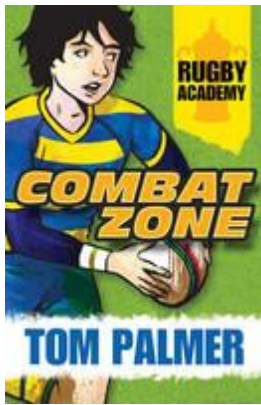


**Over the Line**

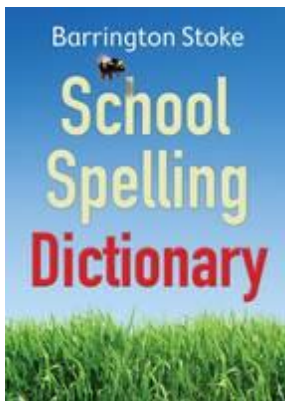
**Rugby Academy: Combat Zone**
